Conducting Lessons

In conducting lessons, I'm committed to working with you to best address your musical goals: whether it's preparing for a performance, brushing up on basic technical issues, or just getting to know your favorite pieces a little better. Lessons will focus on collaborative score study, conducting gesture, and how to make interpretive decisions. I encourage you to record the video and audio of each lesson. All levels are welcome, and packages can be pro-rated by as much as 25%. Please inquire at druckman.holly@gmail.com if you have further questions.

30-min Private Lesson: for targeted review/preparation lessons leading up to a specific performance or audition. Due to the nature of these shorter lessons, I do not offer these in packages greater than 2.

60-min Private Lesson: the best option for students who are working with long-term goals in mind. Most commonly, these lessons are held weekly, but other arrangements are possible too on a case-by-case basis.

Rehearsal-Lessons

For experienced conductors already working regularly with an ensemble. This is a modified lesson that takes place during a rehearsal, in which you'll receive feedback on conducting and general rehearsal technique in real time.

Prior to the coaching, we will work together to determine what your goals are for a session like this and how best to achieve them; this will affect how frequently I give you feedback while you are rehearsing. Due to the nature of this kind of coaching, I do not offer package deals for these sessions.

• Single Session: price negotiable depending on the length of a rehearsal. Typically ~\$100.

Ensemble Clinics

For ensembles; one session of guest-conducting, in which we work together to address specific goals or diagnose areas of improvement. Prior to the session, we will work together to determine what your goals are for a session like this and how best to achieve them. Due to the nature of this kind of session, I do not offer package deals for these.

Single Session: price negotiable depending on the length of a rehearsal.
Typically ~\$120.
